



How it works

- 1. Sign up for AD Circular by contacting your local Avery Dennison sales representative or filling out this form.
- 2. Fill the bale bags with used glassine liners. You can prepare your own bags or purchase them from Interwaste, our waste management partner.
- 3. Interwaste collects the liner waste and ships them off to the recycler to be recycled, at an industry-average fee.
