



All of the convenience, none of the headaches


We will handle all the paperwork and regulatory concerns, including proper documentation and compliance with waste-transport laws.

How it works

- 1. Sign up for AD Circular by contacting your local Avery Dennison representative.
- 2. Review the program business rules provided by Avery Dennison.
- 3. Fill your white glassine liner waste in boxes or bales (that meet the criteria set in the program rulebook) or purchase the boxes from Avery Dennison.
- 4. Store the boxes/bales on export-grade pallets.
- 5. Drop them off at an Avery Dennison collection point or arrange to have them picked-up at minimum cost.
