Applications and Use

The clear material is suitable for heat-sealing trays or similar applications.

C3 is an adhesive that produces a clean reclosure function in the sealing film. This way the sealed package can be opened and closed multiple times. Preliminary testing is recommended.

Conversion and Printing

Thermal transfer printing equipment can be used to add variable information. For best quality wax resin ribbons are recommended.


Shelf Life
